

Emergency Foster Care



WHAT HAPPENS WHEN...

Families experience a crisis and are unable to keep their children safe...

OR

Children experience abuse, abandonment, or neglect...



Emergency Foster Parents are available and on call nights and/or weekends.

Emergency Foster Care is a short term (~30 days) home where children can be safe until a more permanent plan is developed (return home or longer-term care).



*Often times, **Emergency Foster Care** is needed for the care of sibling groups.



Emergency Foster Parents receive reimbursement for care, specialized training, support from social workers, and the feeling that you have made a difference in the life of a child

Emergency Foster Parents can be single or married, have flexible schedules, and offer a stable, caring home for children in need.
