Engaging in conduct that gives Dane County Risk Management reason to suspect that the individual is under the influence of an alcoholic beverage or controlled substance (for example, weaving/stumbling, slurred speech, falling out of a chair, etc.)		Asked to leave for the rest of the day	Asked to leave and not return for 30 days; then next offense(s) will result in a request not to return for 180 days, then a year, then 3 years
DISORDERLY CONDUCT			
Engaging in disorderly conduct that causes, provokes, or tends to cause or provoke a disturbance		Asked to leave for the rest of the day	Asked to leave and not return for 30 days; then next offense(s) will result in a request not to return for 180 days, then a year, then 3 years
Engaging in any physically intimidating or assaultive behavior; this includes but is not limited to fighting with and making threats of violence toward other visitors		Asked to leave and not return for between 30 and 180 days (Request can be adjusted if 911 called and/or facts are discovered later; for example, it may be later discovered that someone engaged in fighting was actually defending themselves against the violent acts of another)	Asked to leave and not return for 180 days; then next offense(s) will result in a request not to return for a year, then 3 years
PUBLIC URINATION/DEFECATION			
No one should urinate or defecate inside the CCB other than into a toilet		Asked to leave and not return for 30 days	Asked to leave and not return for 180 days; then next offense(s) will result in a request not to return for a year, then 3 years
