To add the following language to Sub.1 to Res. 134: After many years of development, Dane County is currently transitioning to a new Computer Aided Dispatch system that can utilize data from GPS or Global Information Systems (GIS) to improve emergency response time for police fire, and emergency medical services. Many of these agencies, including the all of the ambulances in the Dane County EMS System, currently use this technology to help ensure the most appropriate, closest emergency resources are dispatched to critical medical emergencies. In the interest of improving emergency response time and efficiency and full utilization of the county's new CAD System, the Sheriff's Office is directed to install GPS/GIS technology in all Dane County Sheriff's squad cars. The capital budget includes a carry forward of \$27,000 to accomplish this task. Currently, 911 dispatchers in many instances have to manually call sheriff's deputies on the radio to determine their location, prior to determining which deputy is closest to a particular incident.
